July is Fraternal Activities Chairman Joan Johnson month and August is Higher Degree Chairman Bonnie McKenzie.

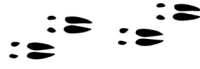

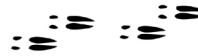
## *Administrator Message*

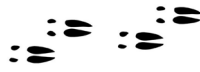
